Create an Easter Garden

Materials:

- pie plate or dish for a terra cotta pot or other low-sided pot about 8-9"
- dirt or gravel
- small pot or other tomb-like vessel
- rock to put in front of tomb
- plants, seeds, moss, etc. (real or fake)
- three crosses made from legos, lashing two small twigs together with twine, or from pipe cleaners
- Small figurine to represent Jesus lego, playmobile, clothes pin
- 1. Put dirt or gravel in the pie or pot plate
- 2. Put down the small pot on its side as the tomb
- 3. Put a rock large enough to cover the opening of the pot in front of the opening
- 4. Mound the dirt over the pot and add seeds or sod cut from your yard or other plants to the dirt.
- 5. Put 3 crosses into the dirt.

On Good Friday you can put the Jesus figure in the tomb and close it with the rock. PARENTS: Then on Easter morning (or Saturday night before you go to bed), you can remove the Jesus figure and set the rock to the side. Some people might even put a small treat there in the tomb!

You can, of course, make this very elaborate and it can become too much of a project. Bear that in mind before you google for any images! I'm giving you this image because I think having a picture will be helpful, but I chose an image that is simple!
